Basic Windows XP by Norma Winner. This four-class course is designed for the new computer user, and covers relatively basic concepts that all users must understand in order to be able to use their computer.

Most of these basic computer and Windows functions and techniques are applicable for any version of Windows. In the four classes you will learn 1) The Desktop: Understanding your work area, the task bar, notification area, icons and the start menu; 2) File and folder management (a critical skill). Managing windows; 3) Cut, copy and paste. Using these for file management. Selecting objects to move, copy or delete. Using a flash drive; 4) Review and introduction to the internet. You can apply these topics working with XP or Vista.

May 4, 11, 18 and 25 from 9-11 AM.

Basic Vista by Steve Kirman. In this four-class course you will learn: 1) The Desktop: Understanding your work area, the Task bar, notification area, icons and the start menu. Things you should know and things you can customize. Review of mouse technique. The sidebar and gadgets; 2) File and folder management (a critical skill). Managing windows. 3) Cut, copy and paste. Using these for file management. Selecting objects to move, copy or delete. Using a flash drive. 4) Speeding up your work by creating and using shortcuts. Printing files or specific text. File management review, using Save and Save As. Internet/email preview.

May 4 and 18 from 7-9 PM.

Selling and buying on eBay, by Tim Neddy. In this two-part course Tim will show you how to sell items on eBay, including setting up an account, pricing items and security issues. In the first class he will put an item up for sale. In Class 2 he will find and purchase items on eBay, and will examine the bidding process for the item auctioned in the first class on May 4. What a great way to learn! He will have plenty of time for your questions.

Advances in computer hardware, by Kurt Sevic. Web Page Design Special Interest Group (SIG) moderated by Bob Schneider. This group is to share ideas and techniques for creating web pages and webs. Lou Labetti will discuss ways to increase traffic to your web site. Come and learn how to set up your own personal family web site, or a web site to help your club or organization.

May 13 from 7-9 PM

Video conferencing with your family. One of the great things you can do with your computer today is to talk with family members using a web cam. A web cam is an inexpensive (\$30-\$50) camera you plug in to send your picture with your voice. Many laptop computers have a built in web cam. They all include a microphone and operate with free software you download from the internet. You and your correspondent only need to choose a time to connect, and you can converse together in a much more fun way. We will show you how to get the software, hook up a camera, and have a great conversation with a loved one.

May 16 from 12-2 PM.

Digital Embroidery Special Interest Group (SIG) moderated by Norma Winner. Karin Bennett will be showing us how to make her "Booty Bag" this month. Please remember to bring your "Show and Tell."

May 20 from 7-9 PM.

Intermediate Internet and email by Lou Labetti. In this class Lou will go over a number of topics that you will find useful if you already know how to use the web. You learn how to set up multiple e-mail accounts, add stationery and voice to your messages, back up your address book, and organize your messages. Lou will also teach you about tabbed browsing so you can have more than one home page, and easily search or read on each but quickly switch to and browse in one of the others. He will also show you how to print just what you want, and will answer any question you have about internet or email.

May 26 from 7-9 PM.

Advanced Digital Picture SIG, Moderated by Tim Neddy. Each month we review our take-home projects and discuss one or two more topics in digital photography and Photo Shop Elements. This month we will share results of macro photography. We ask you to bring your work on a flash drive to share with us.

May 27 from 7-9 PM.

Computer security, by Bob Schneider. Bob will discuss this increasingly important area, and will show you how to use several free programs to help you test your computer security. Make sure your computer is not part of a "bot-net" sending out thousands of emails while you sleep.

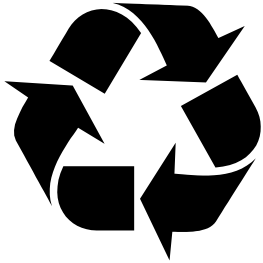
